September	UC: September 1 to September 30 – UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) Application Due <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit TAG to <u>one</u> campus. Review TAG Matrix for participating UC/programs and individual requirements. Use the UC Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) to submit your TAG application CSU: by September 15 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit Degree/Certificate Application petition for AA-T/AS-T available at A&R Forms by September 15th to LPC’s A&R office if you are completing your ADT (AA-T/AS-T) by end of Fall semester 	
October	CSU: October 1-Nov. 30 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit CSU Application for Fall 2025 Admission CSU/UC: Financial Aid <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit Free Application for Financial Student Aid (FAFSA) if open For AB540 or Undocumented students: Submit California Dream Act Application if open 	
November	CSU/UC: November 1 to November 30 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit regular UC applications (including to your TAG UC campus)/ CSU Applications for Fall 2025 Admission Private/Out of State Colleges/Universities <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Varies—check individual university’s transfer admissions webpage about application deadlines 	
December	LPC Scholarships <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Begin working on Personal Statement for LPC Scholarship—for LPC students applications due end of Jan./early Feb. Ask a professor who can write a strong letter of recommendation about you for your LPC Scholarship applications 	
January (Spring)	CSU/UC: by January 31 – Priority Deadline for UC/CSU Application Updates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Log into your UC/CSU Application accounts to report your Fall grades and update/confirm your Spring semester schedule of classes. All applicants must submit this update. Check LPC Scholarships periodically to find out when Scholarship database is open and when applications are due 	
February	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Meet with a Counselor to review remaining degree/transfer requirements. Check your University account(s) for any deadlines for requested documents and/or follow up emails By February 15 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submit Degree/Certificate Application petition for AA-T/AS-T available at A&R Forms by February 15th to LPC’s A&R office if you are completing your ADT by end of Spring semester For CSU EB, send official LPC transcript. If applicable, order official transcripts directly from all colleges attended. 	
March	March 2nd – Deadline to submit FAFSA or California Dream Act Application for 2025-26s academic year	
April	CSU/UC notification of admissions decisions on a rolling basis <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Finish all required courses with a C or better (note: some UC campuses may require a minimum of B grades). This information will be included in your conditional admissions acceptance letter Check LPC graduation webpage about commencement ceremony and process (attendance is optional) --commencement cap/gowns, tickets, etc	
May	CSU/UC: By May 1 (or as indicated): Accepted Admissions Deadline (varies). Submit ONE Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) to your university that you will attend. You may submit only one SIR since you plan on attending only one university. CSU/UC: By May 15 (or as indicated): Submit General Education (CSU-GE or IGETC) Certification Request petition available at A&R Forms to be sent to the <u>one</u> University that you will attend for certain after you have submitted your SIR	
June	By June 15 –Submit final transcript request (ie., hold for Spring grades) to LPC’s A&R office to be sent to your university admissions office <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make sure to order official transcripts directly from any other colleges attended, from your high school, any AP/IB exams to be sent to your university admissions office 	
July	By July 1 –Confirm you sent all required official documents to your university admissions office Attend orientation. Obtain and study the college catalog of those colleges or universities you are planning on attending. Familiarize yourself with their programs, curriculum, grading system, academic calendar, housing options, majors, etc., before you attend.
