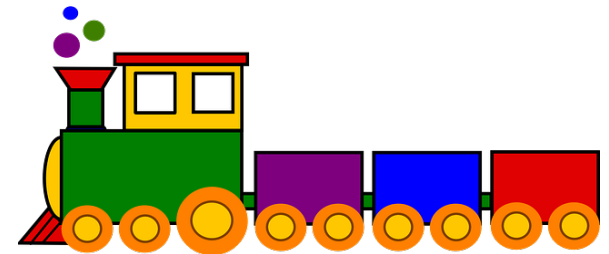
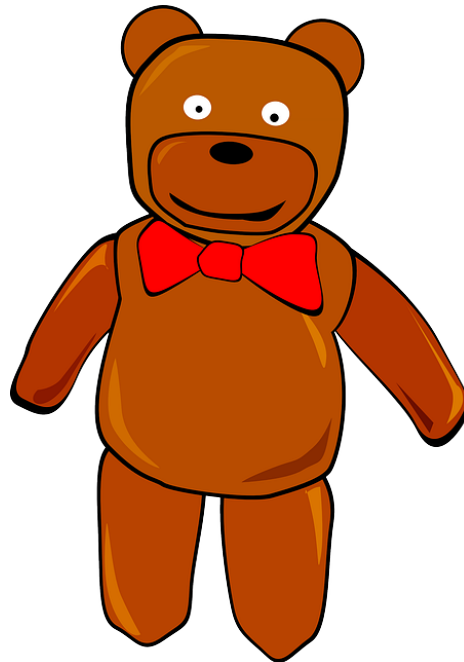
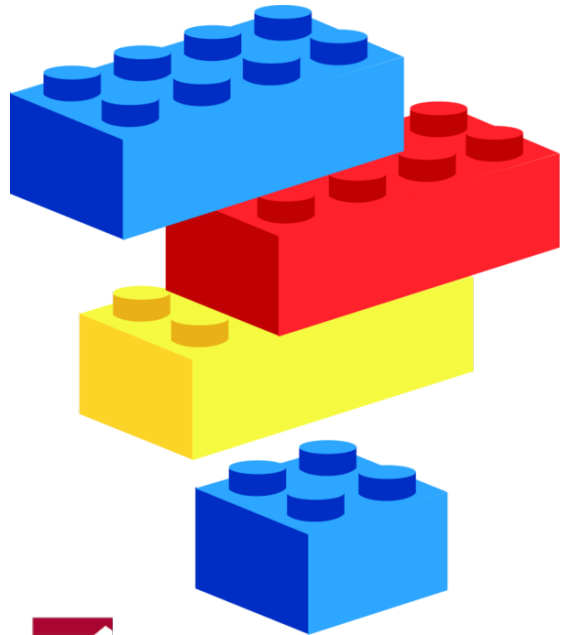
- **Math Jam participants have approximately 10% higher success rate in their subsequent math course compared to the general population.**
