Leslie Payne: ESL face so many challenges, so targeted labs were created to aid student persistence. Noncredit labs.

• Modern Policing, AS:

McQuiston: Assembly Bill signed by gov. for policing reforms. Educated peace officers do better job, raises min. age to 21. He helped create model curriculum for chancellor's office. New degree requirements will take effect and require Modern Policing degree and Bach. Degree in discipline of their choice. New program doesn't replace ADT/AST but can if needed. Intended to be an additional option. New TOP code. Will ignore TOP code currently in CurrIQunet. Has impacts across multiple disciplines. No negative impacts reported by disciplines yet. ARHS might need sequencing changed.

- Physical Therapy Aide, CA: Proposed because Kaiser contacted us, having trouble finding certain position; after discussions, did research to find courses LPC could offer to meet cert.
