Charge of Committee

To elicit broad perspectives and advice regarding facility and sustainability needs of the College in order to serve the greater community through the shared governance process by:

- Providing input and reviewing plans for utilization, maintenance, construction or renovation of facilities in concert with the District.
- Encouraging progress towards more sustainable use of energy, water, open space and other resources by promoting reduced consumption, reuse, recycling, and composting of these resources.
- Providing input, reviewing, and encouraging transportation and campus access strategies that encourage use of public transportation, ride-sharing, bicycle, and pedestrian access.

The Committee will provide an advisory linkage to the college President through college council on all matters pertaining to Facilities and Sustainability in the implementation of Strategic Goals, the college President's Climate Commitment, the Climate Action Plan, the Facilities Master Plan, and the Scheduled Maintenance Plan, Small Projects, District Facilities Committee, and Nike Art on campus task force.
