VP Wilson got us all together and approved for an extension. Thanks to many folks we were able to quickly get the report and data pulled together, submitted and approved</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
6.	<ul> <li>New Business <ul> <li>Budget Commitments</li> <li>Tutorial Center</li> <li>VP Wilson shared that the current year's allocation is 100% on current salaries and benefits.</li> <li>We have had some rollover from past years but these additional funds have been used.</li> <li>VP Wilson and VP Brook'sare in conversations to try to figure out how to find monies for things like printing, supplies. Good news is that we have some rollover from last year: from about \$800k allocated last year, about paid for many of our cultural events (Pride Celebration, Black History Month, Hispanic History Month, etc.). We have a monetary match from Puente for Hispanic History Month.</li> <li>VP Wilson said that next year the funds are up in the air.</li> <li>Jin needs to hire in April for the Fall Tutors and he needs to know if there will be funds available and if so how many. He needs to have an idea of how to pay for tutors for Fall and how many he can hire. VP Wilson will talk to Dr Foster about how to fund tutors next year.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
