	1 May 11 2022	0	This was a great class, not only because of the flexibility but because the instructor was very organized in her presentation of the material and also very accessible.
	2 May 10 2022	0	IMPROVE HOW CANVAS OPERATES!!!! It is IMPOSSIBLE to read-ahead, which is critical for learning and preparation, because of how Canvas hides/publishes dates only days before the synchronous week. It was ALWAYS possible in prior eras of college to "read ahead" or know what would be discussed in 2 weeks to review far ahead of time, take a LONG timeframe to think about topics and perform broad-based reading, but in current era of "Broken" instruction, it is IMPOSSIBLE to do anything other than follow assignments in short-time-frame due dates, when Canvas publishes a new chapter to read or new materials to study only 5 days before the material is due. This is NOT creating a "rich learning environment". Also, there is ZERO tie-in on Canvas to any broader Library materials such as video documentaries, peer-review journals, etc., whereas online learning should use this leverage in digital/streaming educational materials; try assigning library staff to every class with the specific responsibility of finding class-related library materials for each teaching module. The #1 benefit of online instruction is that lectures can be reviewed later from the video recording. In lecture discussion of student projects, I have frequently re-watched the synchronous video (zoom recording). Because of the #1 benefit of HyFlex learning is replaying lecture videos, naturally the #1 question should be: Why is the business-model of instruction based around constantly re-teaching the same material in real-time, compared to having a handful of best-in-class video lecture presentations which are viewable on-demand as part of the class.
	3 May 09 2022	1	I truly feel that it is a waste of valuable time sometimes to be required to sit on zoom class or in person, and have information stretched out compared to taking it in on my own, and asking questions if I feel needed. I have enjoyed moments of in person class, when the class is active doing group projects, etc. But having slides lectured, especially in a small class, being one or two of nine students taking notes.. feels like something I could absolutely do at home. Commuting 45 minutes to take a 30 minute test and be finished also feels to be something I could do from home.
