Las Positas Theater Arts Presents: "A Little Shop of Horrors"

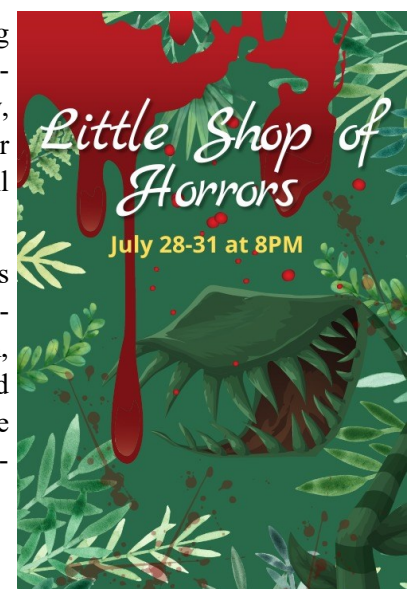

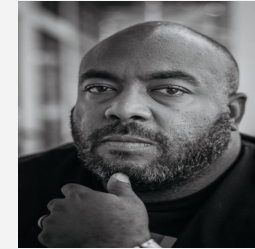
