LPC received notable recognition in the September 5th edition of The Independent, with the headline, "Las Positas College Enrollment Grows 25% Over Past Two Years," and the subhead, "Expanded Programs, Supportive Environment are Major Draws."

The article highlights a 25% increase in enrollment over the past two years. Preliminary figures for this fall show a 9.6% rise from fall 2023, with enrollment exceeding 8,300 for the first time since the pandemic. LPC's fall classes are also currently 95% full, an all-time high.

The growth is attributed to a variety of factors, including the introduction of new academic and trade programs, state-of-the-art facilities, and a focus on creating a supportive campus environment. Recent developments include programs in viticulture and piano technology, as well as new buildings and facilities to support student success.
