4. Industry Updates

Bankhead (Gary)

- Researching safety aspect of reopening Bankhead Theater
 - Need to have a plan to submit to co. health dept. (highly scrutinized, per Carol/TVRT & LHS)
- ESA [working w/ CDC]: Guide to Reopening
 - FEMA toolkit for re-opening: https://www.fema.gov/continuity-resource-toolkit
 - Social distancing, PPE, temp reading (Note: Cannot record a person's name, against HIPAA. Need to create a # for each person.)

Issues

- Disinfecting is very difficult. Most of their volunteers: high-risk
- Difficult to properly social distance & still make money!
- Opening date being pushed further & further back...
- <u>Ideas/Exemplars</u>
 - Disinfect seats (etc.) with electro-static sprayers
 - Rogers AK exemplar, a socially-distanced concert
 - Idea: Social distancing wristband (vibrates when within 6 ft. someone; you'd get that person's info / contact tracing)
 - Set up group to work on a reopening plan? Cohesive approach

L-Shakes (Lisa)

- Has a guide to reopening for outdoor events
 - Will be very time-consuming
- Likely that we'll have to please 5 diff. groups (unions etc.)

LVO (Bonnie)

- Even if we're ready, what about our audience??
- Plexiglass separation or something?

L-Shakes (Lisa)

- Actually, it's not that easy!
 - o Indoors: Woodwind instrument players & singers putting spit out there; air recirculated
- The Event Safety Alliance Reopening Guide: https://www.eventsafetyalliance.org/esa-reopening-guide
- Outdoor venues like L-Shakes will be the guinea pigs! Can really distance seats
- When their office re-opens, it'll be a bit easier
- They'll have a small film studio they're offering to let us use (appropriate lighting, high-quality sound)
 - o 871 square feet
 - Using it for their virtual summer camp
- Bulk-buying stuff / maybe this group could go in on it (Clorox items, stations for hand sanitizing, etc.)

Bankhead (Gary)

- Gary is part of a buying group to procure PPE/sanitization supplies (per his partner)
- Create a Post-SIP Reopening subcommittee with at least 4 people?
 - Note: Gary's a member of ESA -- says he's happy to head it up; would connect us w/ Buying Group
 - They just place an order and they drop-ship it to your address.
 - Gary says he has lots of extra masks, hit him up!
 - LPC's protocol? Not sure...
 - Kelly will check with Vicki

TVRT/LHS (Carol)

- This setup now will only help us in the future...in case we end up online again (L-Shakes/Lisa concurs)
- They're trying to bridge the gap until they can do shows again (applied for EIDC grant, got a nominal amount)
- They have continued [virtual] rehearsals for their LHS productions
- Rehearse-A-Score now digitally capable of synching everyone's digital devices

City of Pleasanton (Mark)

- They have had to cut staff & programming
- They've been doing some online classes; just got the green-light to do more
- They will be offering a camp for essential workers
- Hosting weekly show online, Pleasanton Live (continue engaging audience)
- Planning revenue-based online ticketing format so they can host other artists
- He's personally performed in an online improv show, wasn't too bad!

Douglas Morrison (Christian)

- Shows being canceled through fall
- Took a big hit. Lots of uncertainty right now.
- He's taken part in some Zoom readings, "fine for what they are"
- Considering grants research

L-Shakes (Lisa)

- Grants for individuals: See Theatre Bay Area, CA Arts Council
- Applied for a couple grants for small businesses, PPP received
- Online fundraising campaign
 - Got a \$50,000 match...and then more! Approx. \$120K total. They will probably be fine until Feb '21.
- Ticketed events: Summer camp

- List of artist relief funds
 - Will forward that email to everyone

Self-Employed Actor/Director/Props & Makeup Design (Cyndi)

• Her contracts were all pushed to next summer

 - Mike (LPC / Northern Lights): Need to do training & get it set up, do lighting pkg. design
 - Capacity: 1500 people (really 700-800 comfortably; could open orchestra area too: 100-200 seats)
 - Need outdoor fencing, limited access pts. Not really room for set/costume changes...box-set or open-set?
 - o Projection? Maybe on retaining wall, or wall on rollers

- Maybe do an LPC Outdoor Theater Symposium sometime? (per Erica) L-Shakes, LVO, etc.
