The Constitution of The Christ in Action Club

Article I: The name of our Club

The name of this club shall be The Christ in Action Club

Article II: The Purpose of this Club

We are here to help connect people to Christ, pray for each other and our campus, worship, read the Bible, and share the Word. We seek to fellowship with like-minded Christian students and to welcome all believers and unbelievers alike to interact with us. We are committed to being a presence on campus to encourage faith in Jesus Christ as a Savior and a better way of living.

Article II: Membership

- 1. Any student at Las Positas College may come to and become a member of this club. One is considered a member of this club in any given academic term if he/she has attended at least one club activity and one meeting in the preceding or current term.
- 2. The organization's membership will at all times consist of at least 6 students.
- 3. This organization will not discriminate based on any characteristic listed in The LPC' Student Handbook.
- 4. We do not require any dues for our club membership.
- 5. No voting or decisions are to be made without a club advisor present.
- 6. Outside friends may join our meetings and activities, but may not be involved in making club decisions or voting.

Article IV: Officers

- President: Shall preside over the meetings.
- <u>Vice President:</u> Shall assume the duties of the president in his/her absence.
- <u>Treasurer</u>: Shall give the treasurer's report at the meetings, bring any monies from fundraisers, donations, etc. to the Business Office as soon as possible.
- <u>Secretary</u>: Shall be responsible for taking minutes and typing them up and making sure they are brought to the next meeting. Create fliers and have them approved by Student Life with our legal stamp for posting.

• <u>ICC representative</u>: The ICC representative will attend each ICC meeting. If he or she is unable, another member may attend in their absence to represent The Christ in Action Club at those meetings.

Article V: Elections

- 1. Officers may be elected into office, or they may remain active from the previous, as long as it is in agreement with attending members.
- 2. Any member who is in regular attendance is eligible to run for office.
- 3. We require that someone who is a Christian and has a heart for the Lord grounded and rooted in Christ hold the position of President and Vice President.
- 4. A member is elected if he or she wins with a majority vote.
- 5. The term of office runs the length of the semester, to be discussed and voted on each new semester.
- 6. Student club officers must be enrolled in a minimum of one (1) class per semester and have a cumulative grade point average (GPS) of 2.0 or higher as per the Student Handbook.

Article VI: Meetings

- Meetings shall be held once every two weeks. They are officially 1 hour long, but may run over.
- 2. Meetings shall be presided over by the president, unless he/she is absent, and in that case the Vice President shall preside, followed by the Treasurer.
- 3. All meetings shall have an Advisor in attendance to make decisions and vote.

Article V: Amendments

Amendments to this constitution may be presented at any meeting for discussion and changes shall be made by a majority vote of all members of the club.

Article VI: Impeachment and/or recall

- 1. Any officer is subject to impeachment and or recall and removal from the office for failing to fulfill his/her constitutional responsibilities.
- 2. An impeachment request must be given at least a week in advance of the actual impeachment voting. Both the request and the voting must take place during regular meetings.

- 3. Upon conclusion of the discussion and arguments for and against impeaching the officer, a vote shall be taken. The officer will be impeached with a majority vote. Voting shall be by secret ballot.
- 4. An officer who is impeached shall immediately relinquish his/her office but shall be allowed to maintain active membership in the organization unless his/her actions have brought discredit and/or misconduct to the organization.
- 5. If an officer is impeached, the organization shall fill the position following the procedures outlined under Article IV.

Article VII: End Note

The Christ in Action Club agrees to abide by the rules and regulations in The Student Club Handbook. This constitution and any amendments to it shall be subject to review by the Las Positas College Student Life and LPCSG to ensure that they are in accordance with their Constitution.
