### Guidance from the CCCCO



- Developing Al Literacy in the CCC Guidance
  - Al is transforming work across industries calls for "Fundamental Al Literacy for All" includes call-to-action for instructors, students, deans/admin, and Classified professionals/ managers
- Evolving Instructional Technology Tools in Canvas Memo
  - Al tools are being rapidly developed that can enhance teaching and learning + should be considered in ways that align with our equity goals – promotes "Local Control and System Support"

"Each district retains local control over whether new Canvas features are enabled, and these configurations may be set at either the global or sub-account level through the Canvas Administrator interface. Most features can also be turned on or off by each instructor for a particular Canvas course. Because the impact of these tools reaches deeply into teaching and learning, decisions about adoption are most effective when they are guided by collaboration among Chief Instructional Officers, Distance Education Coordinators, Academic Senate leaders and faculty more broadly."
