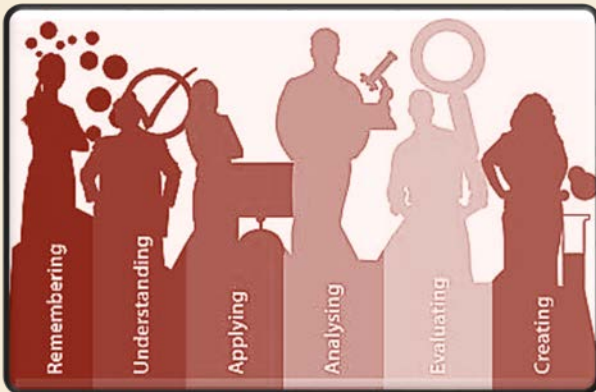

- PROGRESS-TO-DATE
 - Increase tutoring hours
 - from 6,174 (in 2010-11) to 11,172 (in 2015-16)
 - Tutors in Math X classes
 - Scheduled tutoring to cohorts:
 - ECD cohort in math,
 - HSI cohort in STEM classes
 - Engineering Tech cohort in physics
 - New methods of tutoring
 - Implemented NetTutor (online tutoring)
 - Workgroup to consider a Campus Success Center
