NOTE FOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS ON NEW BROWN ACT REQUIREMENTS TO ATTEND VIA ZOOM:

To attend by zoom, committee members must send a request showing "just cause." Just cause is defined as follows:

"(2) "Just cause" means any of the following:

- A. A childcare or caregiving need of a child, parent, grandparent, grandchild, sibling, spouse, or domestic partner that requires them to participate remotely. "Child," "parent," "grandparent," "grandchild," & "sibling" have the same meaning as they do in Section 12945.2.
- B. A contagious illness that prevents a member from attending in person.
- C. A need related to a physical or mental disability as defined in Sections 12926 and 12926.1 not otherwise accommodated by subdivision (g).
- D. Travel while on official business of the legislative body or another state or local agency.
