- POLI 7: Reasons for 4-unit count ~ (1) Guided Pathways efficiency to degree isn't the best; (2) there's no State mandate; (3) there's lots of course content to cover with everything going on in the US & the world; and (4) an important principal skill (argumentative writing) is not taught consistently, so I need to make time for that too.

- EB: For POLI 25 Catalog Description, add "California."
- SM: 25 Evaluation: At least 1 paper per semester w/ a specific # of pp. -very prescriptive. Is this what you want? > Joanna: "At least 6-10 pages" should be the bare minimum, yes.
- EB: 7 is offered at 3 units everywhere else. Why is it 4 at LPC? > See above presenter notes.
- EWB: What's the enrollment been like for 7? > *Joanna: It really varies*.
- CK: For POLI 7, change to "apply" (vs. demonstrate...). Craig changed it in CNET.
- Academic Senate asked faculty to speak to this.
- MN: If you and your Division think this is the appropriate unit-count, that's up to them at the end of the day.
- MZ: For her students, the workload is a lot for them /they tend to shy away from this if they're not a POLI major
- JG: For American Institutions requirement --HIST 7, HIST 8, POLI 7 → Students tend to choose 3-unit options.
- EWB: There's a place for some higher-unit courses. She's had to defend her Global Cinema course similarly.
- CK: With common course numbering, this may need to change (They're pushing for common course outlines).

- This is regulated by the State.
- She worked on Title V revisions.
  - See highlights in Mary's PowerPoint presentation (01/29/24 all-campus CC invite).
- For working students in all majors -- they can earn LPC units for their jobs.
- Some courses are online and required by a number of programs (e.g., ENGR Tech).
- Next Step: She will notify all of the program coordinators who were affected by these changes.

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- Per CIWEA (CA Internship & Work Experience Association) There are no limits.
- Courses impacted: WRKX 94 & 95. > CK: Apprenticeship work-experience (94) courses too
- Key change: Fewer work hours per unit.
- She will need to update her courses to reflect these changes.
  - And apprenticeships authors should modify theirs too.
- Note: These are late start classes.

- CK: Is there something in writing with CCCCO? > Mary says yes, and she'll email it to him.
- JG: In what scenario would it be worth it for a student to enroll in 14 units in a semester?
  - Mary: There are certain programs/jobs that it makes sense for she can email those.
- CK: What's the impact on financial aid?
  - o Mary: You can't get financial aid to cover this beyond 2 enrollment periods.
- EB; Also, we can now do work experience as noncredit.
- MN: How about offering this as Fast Track in the future?
- All: This is worth sharing widely -- at FLEX Day, Town Meeting, and/or a Tour of Division Meetings.
