5.	Report from CEMC/DEMC Strategy Meeting DEMC met and we still don't have an allocation so we don't have a target. It was made clear that there is no money. VP Ho shared and explained updates to her "homegrown spreadsheet" used for analysis. We are still using the target from last year to do our analysis. The new CLPCCD allocation worksheet was found to be faulty, or there could be user error; not sure. To test it, VP Ho and Prof. Powers plugged in numbers from last year but couldn't get the numbers to line up. This issue was taken to the CEMC/DEMC strategy meeting. So we are waiting to hear back to know the solution.
