All History courses fulfill General Education Requirements. For example, History 7 & 8 meet the US Institutions Requirement. We also have courses like History 32 that fulfill the American Cultures requirement. In addition all of our courses can be used to complete the AA Transfer Degree in History as well as other Transfer Degrees.

Not applicable however the facilities, support staff and student demand are in place. We currently have three full time faculty. We need a minimum of one additional full time positions, and that would bring our total to four full time positions. We currently have less full time faculty than several disciplines much smaller than History.

7. What are the impacts on students, the discipline and the college of NOT filling this faculty position? What are the programs/courses/services that have not been or cannot be offered due to the vacancy? (Be brief and specific. Use your Program Review to complete this section.)

The History Program will continue to offer the same number of sections--staffed instead with part-time faculty. There may be a difference in the quality of instruction and a potential lack of availability of faculty to meet regularly with students. It is increasingly difficult for the History Program to expand course offerings to meet demand and to develop desperately needed World History courses and to re-activate the African American and Mexican American History courses. The three full time historians all have a strong background in US History. A full time faculty member is needed who can teach and revise the Western Civilization courses. We also are in need of more full time faculty who can teach distance education courses. It is difficult to cover staffing during sabbatical and workload banking leaves. Most importantly, more full time faculty are needed to complete the heavy and increasing administrative workload demanded of all college programs including SLOs, yearly Program Review updates, scheduling, peer evaluations, and new adjunct hiring.
