aving a variety of colors in scrimmage vests will give a greater number students an opportunity for more class rticipation instead of lag time that can be created with sharing a certain color vest between one or more groups. so will allow for more flexibility in dividing the various skill levels during activity and intercollegiate courses making easier for the instructor to identify.

SLOs are reinforced allowing for greater student participation by giving the students an opportunity to participate more instead of using time to change and swap a certain color vest between one or more teams. Having different colors and larger quantity should prevent the down time created from swapping vests during class.
