SSCCC Delegate Appointment – T. Tieu <i>Action Item</i> 20 minutes	T. Tieu will propose an LPCSG officer to serve as the delegate for Student Senate for California Community College (SSCCC), as the Parliamentarian has not yet been elected. T. Tieu will explain the voting procedures for the delegate appointment:

Item & Presenter	Description
	1. All LPCSG officers, except for the LPC Student Trustee, are eligible to serve as the SSCCC delegate. 2. Any officer may nominate themselves, or another officer, to serve as the SSCCC delegate. 3. Officers who intend to run for the SSCCC delegate position shall each speak no longer than one (1) minute. 4. A vote for the SSCCC delegate position will be conducted, where the officer with the most votes shall become the delegate. 5. Each officer will vote or abstain completely; in the event of a tie for the position, a second vote shall occur where the run-off candidates will speak for an additional one (1) minute. 6. If any continuing officer does not meet the eligibility requirements under the LPCSG Bylaws Article 2, Section 2, they will be removed from LPCSG. Per the LPCSG Bylaws: Article VI, Section 1: “If the LPCSG Parliamentarian is unable to attend an SSCCC meeting or event, LPCSG will appoint a replacement by a ⅔ majority vote for the stated meeting or event.”
