- Omri: Possible for a proposal for a music tech lab that's separate?
- Chris: Any alternative solutions (other space on campus)? STEAM building, computer lab?
 (latter: utilize cart with MIDI controllers)
- Maybe we start this process again w/ the start of a new LPC President?
- Start with a discussion with our A&H Dean.

Other Items

- Overhaul: New LPC music studio engineering room & isolation chamber (replacing old music library) teach recording concepts. It should be ready by fall.
- Curriculum is not changing for a while, other than the all-online Piano Pedagogy certificate.
 - It'll go on OEI (Online Education Initiative) can get credit anywhere in the state

Attrition issues:

- About 50% attrition in LPC Music
- Many students take Music Intro classes just to explore; don't continue on.
- And students end up transferring before completing an AA/AS degree...
