The majority of the comments were positive toward distance education at LPC. Many students expressed their appreciation for LPC offering classes online, particularly during the pandemic. Students mentioned that they were able to work full time, spend more time with their families, didn't have to battle traffic, didn't have to risk getting family members sick, and didn't have to arrive home after a late-night class on campus. A couple of students were thankful for online classes because they were unvaccinated and couldn't register for on-campus classes. Students made specific comments about how much they enjoyed their classes and praised the instructors. Students noted that the number of online classes at LPC should be expanded. Multiple students mentioned that the quality of the online course depends on the ability of the instructor to properly design and teach the course. Students who were not happy with their online experiences cited the lack of interaction that the instructor had with students and that students had with other students. One problem was that some instructors did not seem comfortable working online, particularly with the technology. Other complaints included: having to use Proctorio, class organization and structure not being standardized, group work, long grade turnaround time, instructors who don't speak English well, and counselors not replying to students.
