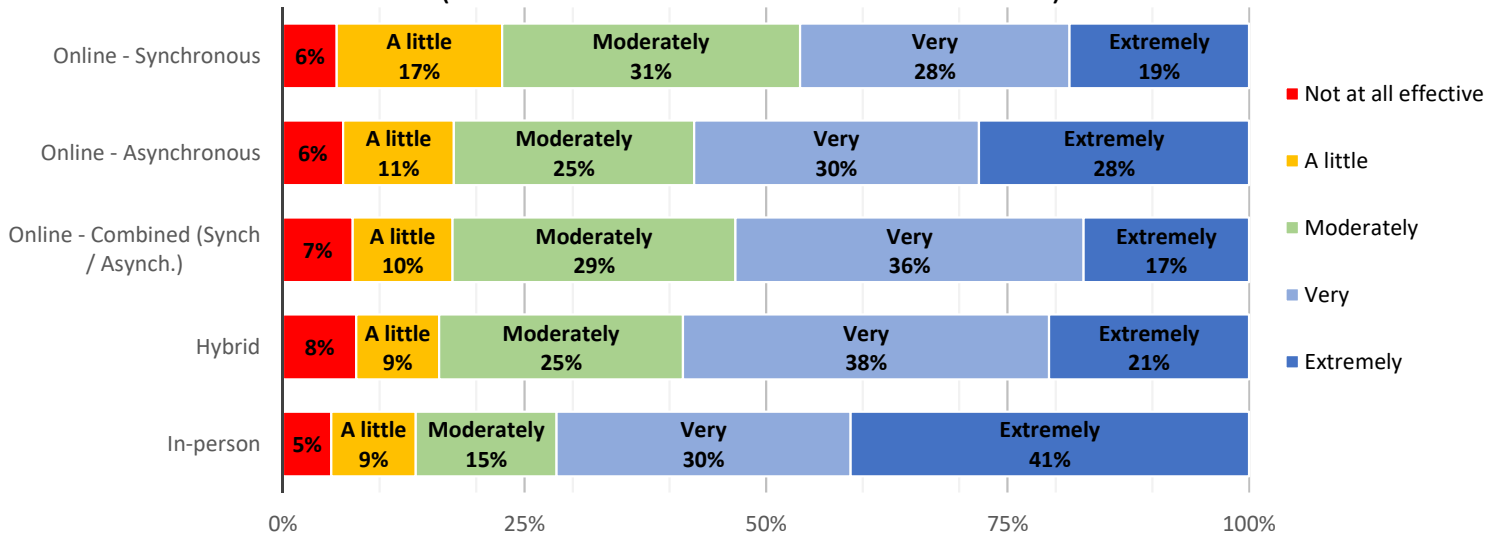

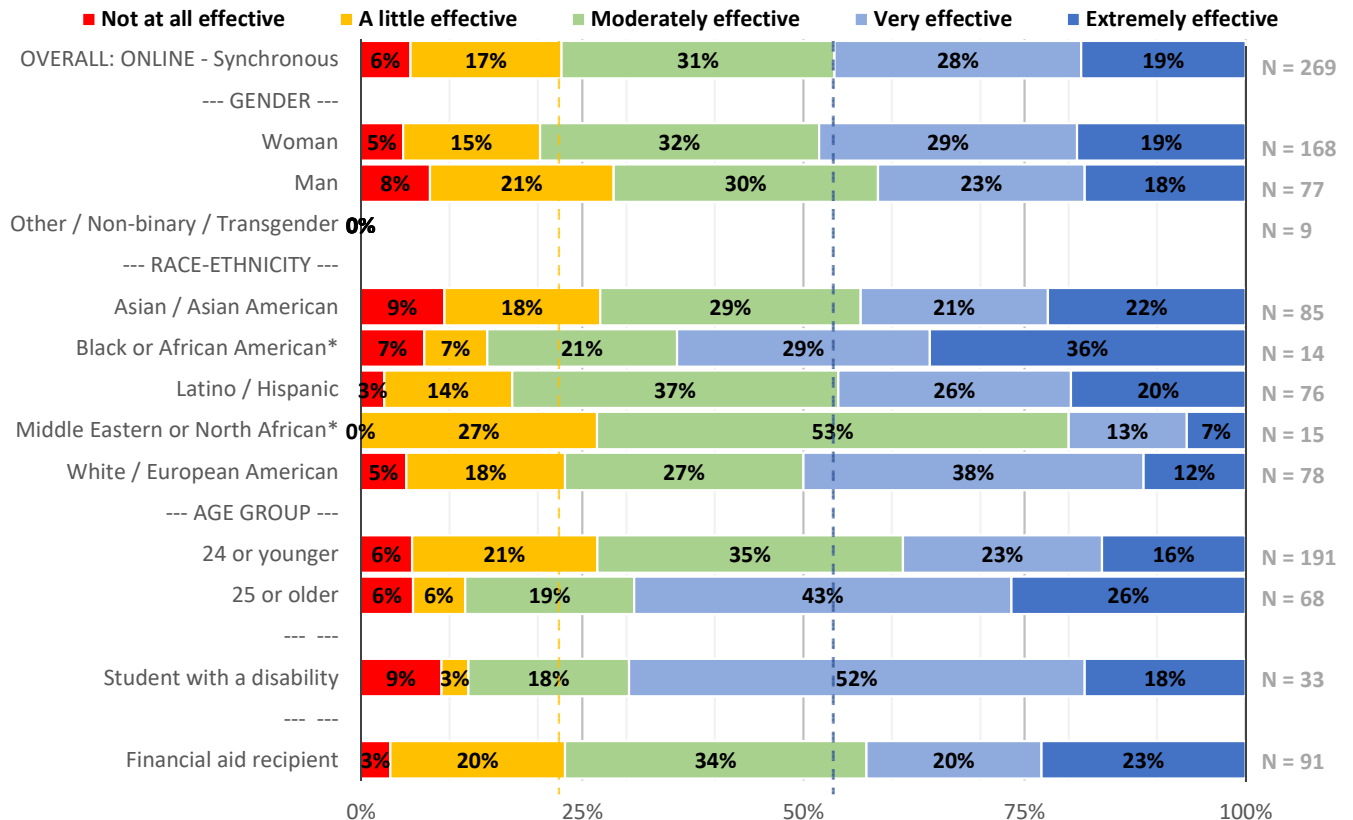

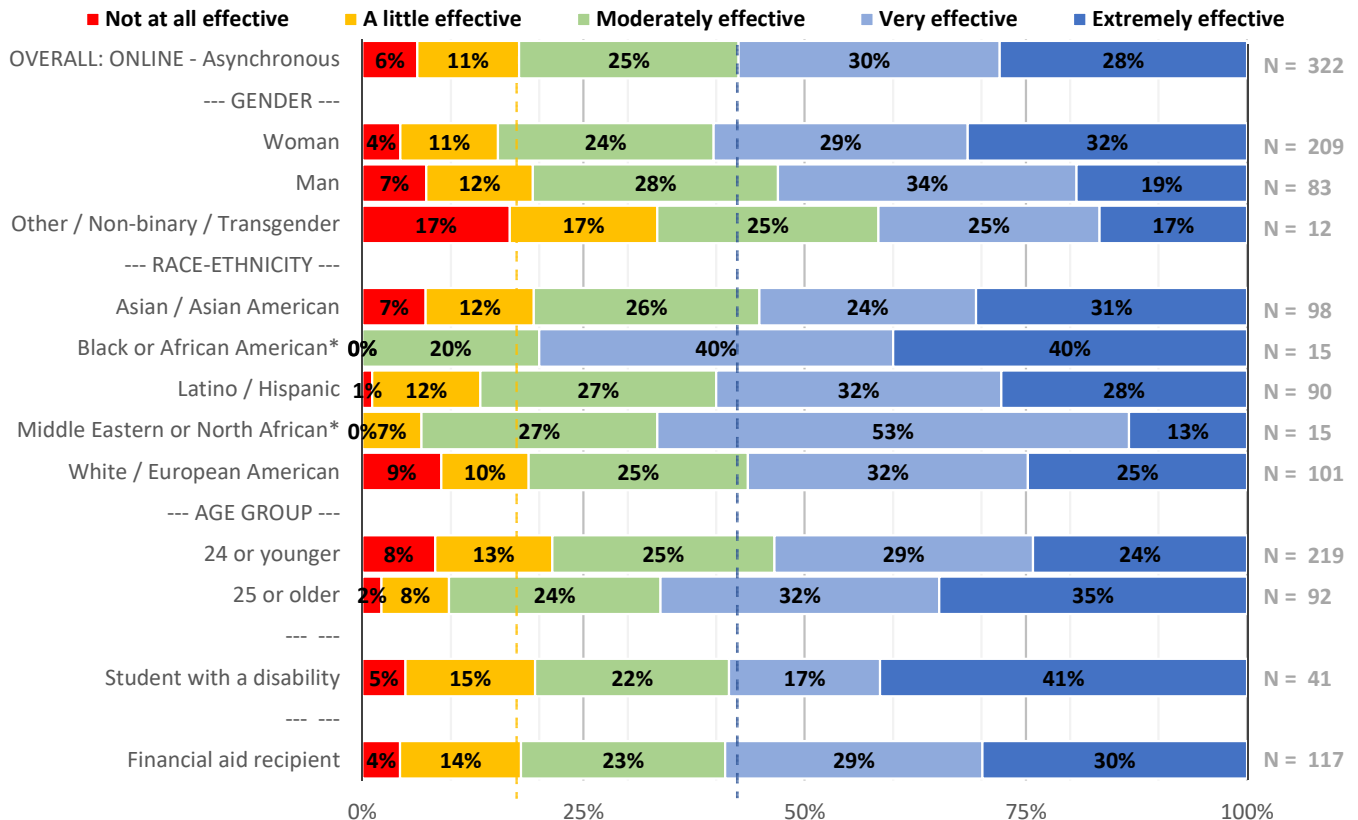
**Effectiveness of Online Synchronous Instruction**

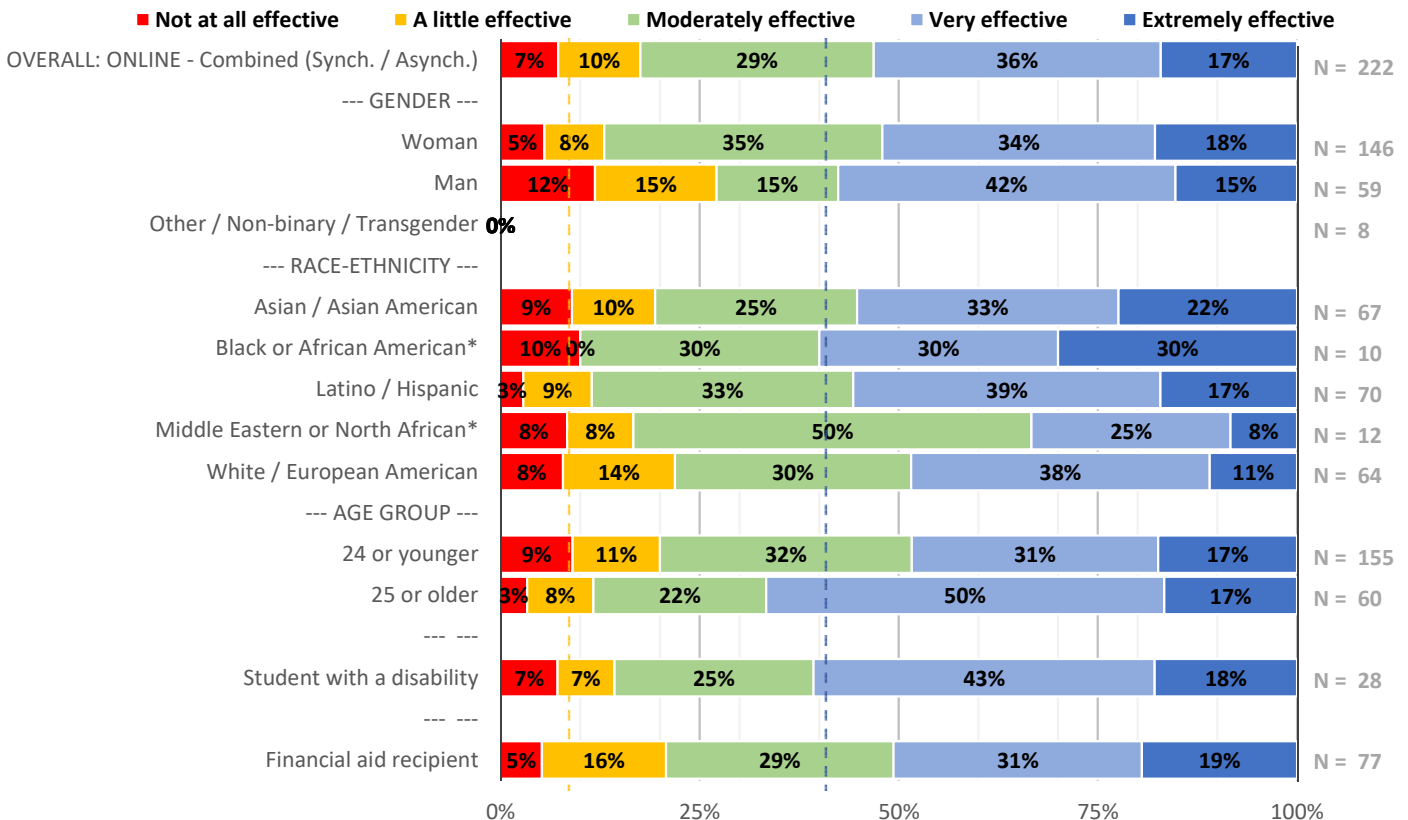
**Effectiveness of Online Asynchronous Instruction**

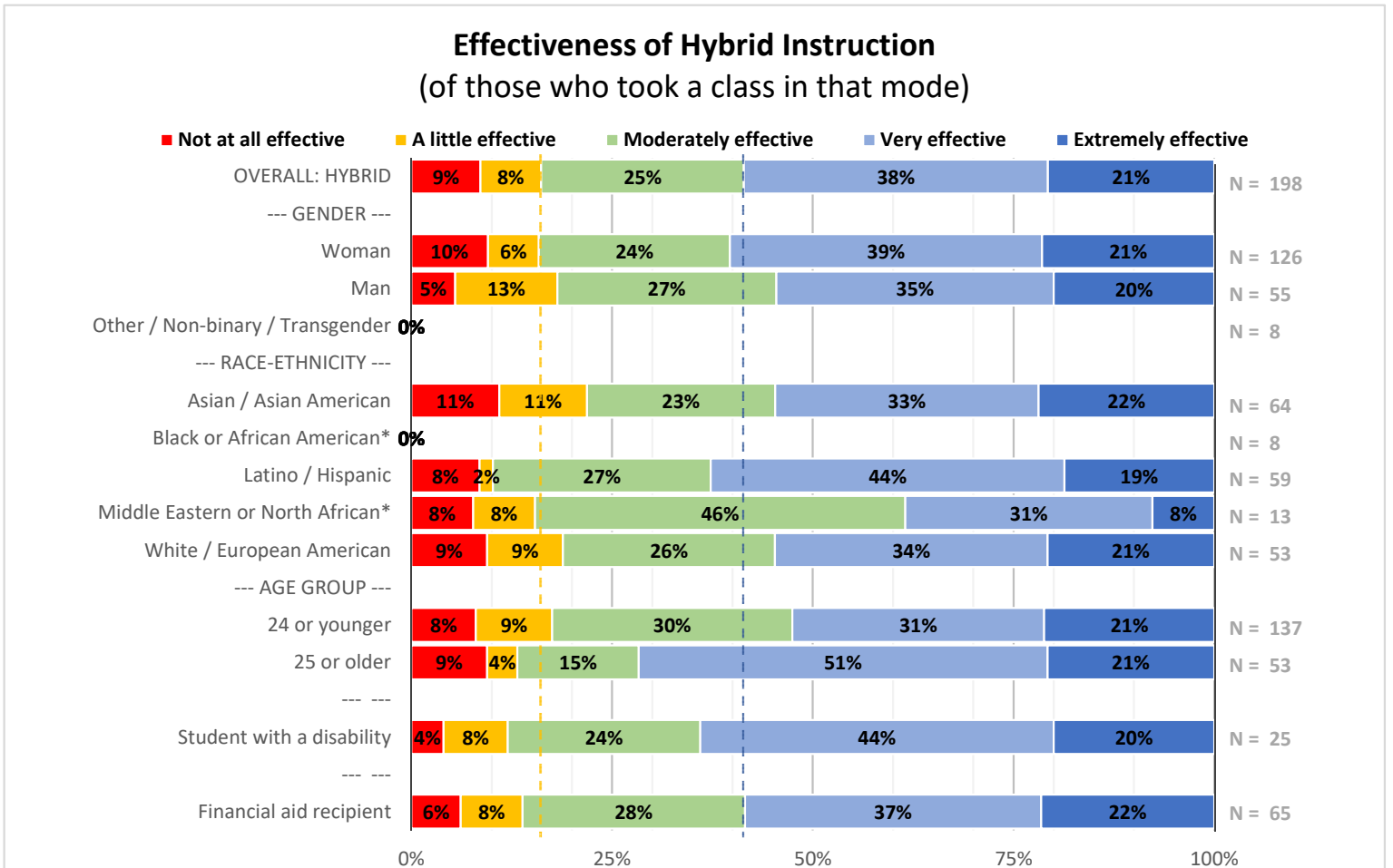
