The University of Arizona has an exclusive offer for California residents. We will guarantee admission for any California resident with an IGETC or CSU GE certificate and a GPA of 2.0 or higher. We also guarantee the acceptance of all certificate courses toward *lower division general education requirements for the UA degree.

The completion of the IGETC or CSU GE certificate must appear on your community college transcript. Please be sure to follow up with an advisor from the awarding institution, to ensure that all requirements are met, and that your official transcript will show completion of the awarded certificate.

FOR ANY CALIFORNIA RESIDENT WITH :

- ▶ IGETC or CSU GE certificate
- ▶ GPA of 2.0 or higher

LOWER DIVISION GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Students transferring to the University of Arizona from California with an IGETC or CSU GE certified by a California community college will have completed the majority of the University's lower-division General Education requirements. The IGETC will fulfill the following lower-division General Education requirements at the University: freshman composition, mathematics-General Strand, Tier One and Tier Two-with the exception of the Natural Sciences and the Diversity Emphasis course. To complete the Natural Sciences, the student's college/major advisor will need to validate completion of two laboratory science courses at the transfer institution or at the UA. To satisfy the Diversity Emphasis requirement, the student's advisor will need to verify completion of a course that focuses on gender, race, class, ethnicity, sexual orientation, or non-western studies.

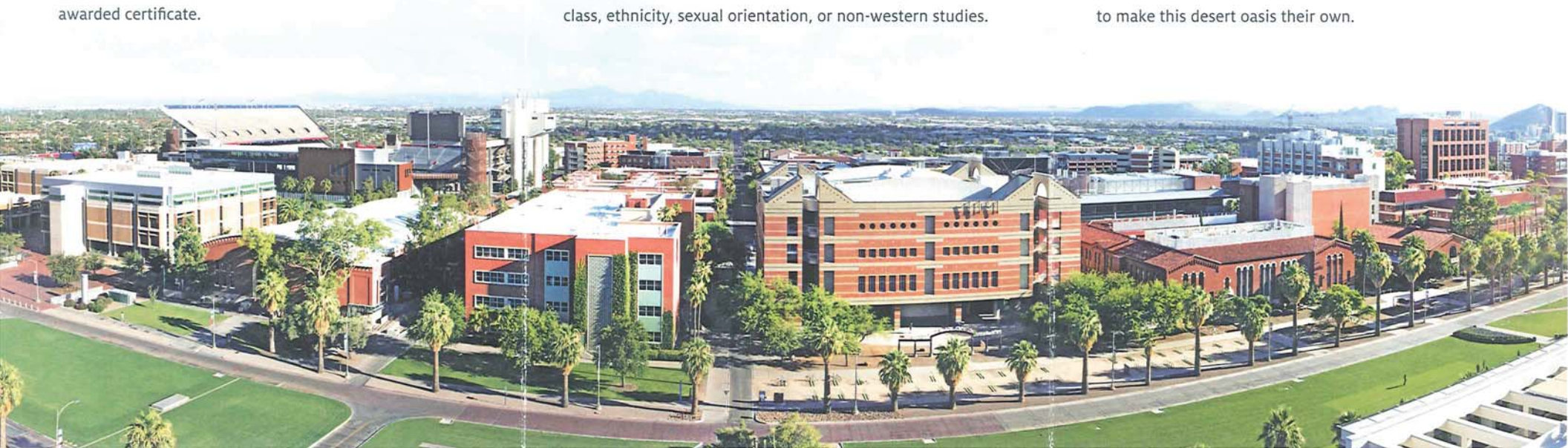
